



## The Padelford Scholarship Fund

The Padelford Scholarship Fund awards scholarships to full-time and part-time seasonal student employees working on the Padelford Riverboats and the Minnesota Centennial Showboat.

- The **Fallon Bowell Scholarship** is awarded to a Padelford Company employee in honor of a remarkable young student-employee and family member who died tragically in a traffic accident in 2002. One student will be awarded \$2,000. The runner-up awards are designated as the **Padelford Riverboat Scholarship**. Two students will be awarded \$500 each.
- The **Lance Brockman Showboat Scholarship** is awarded to a Showboat Company member in honor of the U of M theatre professor who was the primary driving force behind the rebirth of the Minnesota Centennial Showboat, both as a theatre venue and as a theatre program. One student will be awarded \$2,000. Runner-up awards are designated as the **Vern Sutton Scholarship** and the **Jean Montgomery Scholarship**. Two students will be awarded \$500 each.
- The **Mintáhoe Hospitality Scholarship** is awarded Mintáhoe Hospitality employee. One student will be awarded \$2,000, and two students will be awarded \$500 each.

### Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must be a graduating high school senior, a returning undergraduate or vocational student, or a graduate student enrolled in an accredited post-secondary institution during the next succeeding academic year who is actively engaged in a degree-granting program as a full-time or half-time student as defined by the enrolling educational institution. *Previous applicants who have been awarded \$2,000 are not eligible to reapply. Students who have previously received \$500 awards may apply again.*
