APPLICATION INFORMATION SHEET

Purpose of the Somerset Country Club Scholarship Fund
--

To provide funds to finance, or aid in financing, the post-secondary undergraduate education of one or more qualified applicants at any accredited two-year or four-year college, university or vocational/technical school.

Scholarship Awards

- One or more awards of up to \$6,000 will be made annually.
- Scholarship grants will be paid to the enrolling post-secondary educational institution on behalf of the scholarship recipient.
- Scholarship funds are to be used for tuition, fees, books, and required supplies.
- Recipients and non-recipients may reapply in succeeding years if they meet the scholarship eligibility criteria as defined at the time of reapplication.
- If a recipient enrolls in a school other than the one to which she/he was originally admitted, or transfers to another qualifying educational institution, she/he will not forfeit the scholarship award if The Saint Paul Foundation is notified in advance of such a transfer.

Scholarship Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must

- be enrolled, or planning to enroll in the year in which the award is made, as a full-time or part-time undergraduate student at an accredited two-year or four-year college or university or a vocational/technical school; and
- be current (employed by Somerset Country Club as of the application deadline date) full-time employees or current part-time seasonal employees of Somerset Country Club; or
- be current employees, caddies or other independent contractors working for the Club golf professional; or
- be children or grandchildren of persons meeting the criteria of (1) or (2) above; and
- have worked a minimum of 160 hours at Somerset Country Club in the calendar year immediately preceding application, or
- if a caddie, have worked 16 rounds of golf.

Scholarship Selection Criteria

Decisions of the Scholarship Committee will be based solely on the applicant's record and will take into consideration

- academic achievement;
- leadership ability;
- active participation in school and community activities;
- honors, and a statement of educational and career goal; and
- other factors deemed appropriate by the scholarship selection committee.

Preference will be given to qualified applicants entering the freshman year of post-secondary education.

No awards will be given for graduate studies.

Application Procedures

1. Complete the Scholarship Application (front and back sides of all pages) attached to this sheet, or download it at www.saintpaulfoundation.org. (Click on "Scholarships," then "S.")
2. Give the School Evaluation/Letter of Recommendation to a current teacher or counselor and ask that it be completed according to the directions provided.
3. Ask your school for an official transcript, including ACT or SAT scores. Copy the transcript and blank out all identifying information on the copy. Send the official transcript and the copy with your application.
4. The Scholarship Committee uses a blind selection process. Follow carefully any directions about removing or excluding information that would identify you to Scholarship Committee members affiliated with the Somerset Country Club (i.e. name, how long employed and positions held at Somerset Country Club).
5. Mail all application materials listed above, unfolded, in a large (9" x 12") envelope to:

Postmark deadline date for scholarship application and all supporting documents:
Monday, June 21, 2010.

- Applications will be considered only if the above directions are followed accurately.
- It is your responsibility to ensure that the application form and supporting application materials (i.e. School Evaluation, transcript(s) and letter of recommendation) are submitted on a timely basis. Incomplete and/or late applications may not be considered.
- Applications are reviewed by the Scholarship Committee.
- All applicants will be notified of the outcome of their applications by early -- mid-August.
