- Applicant must be in full-time status, as defined by the post-secondary institution you are attending.

- Transcript. (unofficial accepted)
- An essay describing your involvement in the Indian community. The Two Feathers Endowment seeks to support the post secondary education of American Indian Students who, in the judgment of the Endowment, best exemplify the Endowment's motto "We Care and We Share." Explain how the accomplishment of your educational goals will benefit the American Indian community. Essay must be limited to 250 words and be typed.
- A letter of reference from an academic counselor. The Two Feathers Endowment seeks to support the post secondary education of American Indian Students who have demonstrated academic excellence and who best exemplify the Endowment's motto "We Care and We Share." Your counselor should describe how they know you and how receiving this scholarship will advance your academic standing toward graduation. Your counselor should also describe your current academic status toward achieving a degree.
- A letter of reference from a community member. The Two Feathers Endowment seeks to support the post secondary education of American Indian Students who have demonstrated academic excellence and who best exemplify the Endowment's motto "We Care and We Share." The community member should describe how they know you and how you have contributed to the improvement of the American Indian community through public service or volunteer activities. They should describe any activities they feel have benefited the community.
- Proof of being a lineal descendant of a federally recognized tribe.

The omission of any of these documents will render your application incomplete and will not be reviewed.
